Emmet County Conservation Watercraft Rental Policy

- 1. Renters must be 18 years of age or older and present a valid photo id. Renters under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian and the rental will be in-care of the parent/guardian.
- 2. It is recommended that renter have prior watercraft experience.
- 3. **Reservations MUST be made in person or over the phone during Nature Center hours (Monday-Friday 8-4). **
- 4. Reservations not made 24hours in advance cannot be guaranteed.
- 5. Rental fees need not be paid at the time of reservation but must be paid-in-full before use.
- 6. The rental fee for 1 person is \$10 per 2 hours. Refunds will NOT be given if renter cannot make it out the day of rental.
- 7. The rental fee may be paid by cash or *check. No credit cards. *DL/ID# must be presented with check.
- 8. The renter MUST provide a valid form of photo identification.
- 9. All equipment must be returned by 3:00pm during regular Nature Center hours or by the end of the float for organized events, unless previously arranged. <u>Failure to return any and all equipment in the condition that it was in was in prior to rental, will result in a fine up to \$750.00. A cleaning fee will be assessed if the equipment is not returned in the same condition as it was in prior to rental, i.e. full of mud or sand.</u>
- 10. No equipment will be considered returned until the renter returns it to Emmet County Conservation personnel, or to the designated rental stall.
- 11. Upon return all equipment will receive a full inspection.
- 12. Renter will be charged current replacement costs for any equipment lost or returned with such extensive damage as to warrant replacement.
- 13. <u>The destination can only be High Lake unless this rental is part of an organized event on another body of water with</u> <u>Emmet County Conservation personnel or approved by Emmet County Conservation personnel.</u>
- 14. <u>The renter will not transport the equipment. Only Emmet County Conservation personnel will transport the</u> <u>equipment, unless previously approved by Emmet County Conservation personnel.</u>
- 15. Renter must write on the rental form the destination, float time, and paddling partners and will follow through as indicated.
- 16. Renter MUST be the one in the boat rented.
- 17. U.S. Coast Guard Max Capacity Regulations must be followed.
- 18. Emmet County Conservation personnel reserve the right to refuse a request based on prior experience, attitude and skill level of participant, river levels, and weather conditions.
- 19. All renters and persons in a rental boat will wear a provided proper-fit PFD (lifejacket) at all times while on and near a body of water.
- 20. Failure to comply with any ECCB ordinance or rental policy will result in: fine(s), loss of rental and usage rights to any or all ECCB areas, equipment and activities.
